This is a public speaking contest, not a demonstration – "acts" and the use of props are both to be discouraged. It is also not intended to be a spoken research project. Any topic may be selected. One of the judges' criteria is "suitability for this age group", and the speech <u>must be the student's own work.</u>

Opening (15%)

- does it gain audience attention?
- does it set proper tone for the subject?
- does it serve to introduce the subject

Material (30%)

- is it well organized logical?
- does it make a point and follow through (e.g. with illustrations or examples?)
- is it suitable for this age group?

Delivery (40%)

- can the speaker be heard?
- does the speaker have good platform manners?
- eye contact?
- spoken rather than read?
- is the tone of voice suitable?
- hesitation, mis-pronunciation?
- good use of voice, expressions, face?

Ending (15%)

- re-emphasize the mainpoint?
- leaves the desired impression?
